## Permit Requirements / Restrictions

- The Corporation of the County of Peterborough requires the applicant to provide proof of insurance coverage (attached hereto and forming part of this application) in the amount of a **minimum of \$5 million, naming the Corporation of the County of Peterborough as an additional insured.**
- Permit **applications are to be received** by the Corporation of the County of Peterborough **at least 2 business days prior to the move.**
- The permit holder is responsible to ensure that insurance coverage does not expire during the tenure of this permit and is responsible to apply annually for same.
- The County of Peterborough reserves the right to inspect any load at any time at its sole discretion.
- This permit does not apply to roads or structures with posted load limitations.
- Oversize loads transported on County roads without posted load limitations shall be subject to M.T.O. permit conditions with regard to axle loading, including seasonal limitations.
- The permit applicant is advised that the Gannons Narrows bridge (located between County Road 16 and County Road 37) is 4.3 metres high, and the bridge located on County Road 10 north of Highway 115 is 4.4 metres high.
- Category II Moves:
  - are permitted **during daylight hours only** and
  - are **not permitted** on weekends or statutory holidays.
- The applicant is advised that this permit is void on any County roads under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the County of Peterborough that are under construction at the time of the move.
- The person or company for whom this permit is issued agrees to hold harmless the Corporation of the County of Peterborough for any damage which may result from the movement of the oversize load or object, and indemnify the County for any damage caused to County property.
- The permit holder must contact any affected utility company at least 48 hours prior to the move to arrange for any protection or alteration of their facilities.
- The permit holder is responsible to arrange for personal or police escort, if required.
- The permit holder is responsible for flags/markers on overhanging loads.
- The permit holder is responsible to ensure that any overhead obstructions are clear.
- The permit holder is responsible for checking their proposed route prior to commencing their move to ensure there are no obstructions of any kind.
- The permit holder is solely responsible to ensure that all applicable municipal, provincial and federal laws, regulations and acts shall be complied with at all times, including but not limited to, all employees, owners and sub-contractors utilized by the permit holder.
